Guaranteed Asset Protection helps fill the gap between your vehicle insurance payment and your loan balance if your vehicle is a total loss. The Plus will pay \$1,000 towards your next loan if you use the GAP coverage. Deductible Assistance helps pay your deductible on up to 2 claims per year for the life of the loan. Coverage cost \$295. Mechanical Repair Coverage is an extend warranty program that can help limit the cost of any covered repairs on new or used vehicles. No loan required. Rates vary by vehicle and plan selection. Credit Life and/or Disability insurance pays the loan or the payments up to \$30,000. Cost added to loan payment.
